

# 1995 - 1997 JAGUAR

## ABS MODULE REMOVAL

1. Remove the tray that is supposed to hold the tools. Simply pull up the rubber strip, unscrew the 2 pegs inside the tray and lift the tray. This will give you free access to the pump.
2. Unplug the main harness going into the ABS pump/module. There is a 10mm screw that holds the harness into the pump/module. The screw will not come out completely, but will unscrew so you can pull the harness
3. Undo the 2 screws (13MM) on the front and 1 (13MM) on the back of the pump/bracket.
4. Lift the ABS pump/module off of the bracket. You will have plenty of room without damaging the brake lines. They are extremely flexible with a lot of available movement.
5. There are 2 bolts that secure the module to the pump. There is one at the very front of the module (in the middle) & one screw about 2 inches from the rear of the module going toward the front (in the middle). You can easily feel where the bolts are by feeling under the module (with the indent). Remove the bolts with a 6 point 20 star socket.
6. The module then drops down.
